
Join us for EXTREME FUN!

### Costume Deposits

Even though our gym show and dance concert seem so far away, we are already formulating ideas for themes and costumes. Please remember that costume deposits will be due with your November Tuition. Gymnasts pay a \$35 deposit. Dancers pay a \$35 deposit and an additional \$35 deposit with February tuition. Final Balances will be due in May & June. For Gymnasts, we try leotards (girls) and shorts/shirts (boys) on in class in February or March. Dancers will be sized by teachers.

# Some Friendly Reminders From the Front Desk

Tuition is based on an annual fee that is broken into 10 equal payments for gymnastics and 9 equal payments for dance *for your convenience*. Any personal holidays, school vacations, or sick days may not be discounted from monthly tuition. We do provide make-up classes for students who are sick. They should make up the class during that month, if possible. **All tuition is due the first lesson of each month**. Any payments made after the 21<sup>st</sup> of the month are subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Should the late payment go beyond the late payment date of the next month, suspension from class will result. Student may return after account is paid. Any check returned is subject to a \$20.00 bank fee.

We encourage parents to label all of their children's clothing, shoes, grips, etc. to avoid confusion in the waiting room. We do have a lost & found. It is emptied monthly and given to charity.

So as not to interrupt the learning process in the classes, we would appreciate it if students or parents would check in with the secretary each week.

Parents, please do not drop off students any earlier than 15 minutes before their class time. Also, please make every effort to pick up students on time.

**Dancers**, please make sure you come to class dressed in appropriate dance attire. This consists of a one piece leotard and tights and the appropriate shoes. Hair needs to be tied back.

**Gym Dress Code - Girls** should have leotards (please, no attached skirts, for safety) stretch shorts over are allowed, no tights or socks, no jewelry and **hair pulled back. Boys** should wear shorts or sweats, T-shirt or sweatshirt and no socks.

There are some students who have severe nut allergies. Please do not bring any food containing nuts into the building. Thank you!
